Instructions Game 1 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Allocate children to small groups of 4-5. Give them a small card to draw or name an item they would put in a bin at home. 2. Introduce the children to their 3 bins. Recycling, Garden and Household Waste. 3. Ask them to empty their rubbish bag into the centre of the table and lay the 30 images (which they have drawn or named) face down. 4. Explain that their job is to sort the rubbish from their bag into the correct bins, if they put their item into the correct bin they receive a point. The person with the most points at the end of the game wins. Instructions Game 2 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Allocate children to small groups of 4-5. 2. Introduce the children to their 3 bins, Recycling, Garden and Household waste. 3. Ask them to empty their rubbish bag of 30 images into a pile in the centre of the table 4. Set the timer. Shout 'Sort'. The children work as a team to recycle their items quickly and correctly. They must hold up their hands when they finish. Their times must be recorded. 5. Upon completion, review the bin contents in a whole class manner & any incorrectly recycled items will incur an added second onto the teams time.
