

How to make a cardboard aquarium!

You will need:

Scissors
Glue
Cardboard
Loo roll tubes
Paintbrush
Felt tip pens
Scrap paper, fabric, tissue, etc. for decoration



- 1 Start by squashing your loo-roll tube flat and drawing the fish outline - make sure you leave some of the tube attached.



- 2 Use felt tip pens, paint or whatever you have to decorate your fish. You can use old cardboard to make extra decorations for your aquarium too.

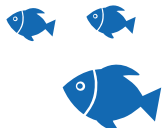

- 3 Cut a panel out of the front of a box to create your aquarium. A shoe box or cereal box is a good choice.



- 4 Decorate your inside to look like an aquarium scene. You'll find plenty of materials to use in your recycling bin.

Ask a grown up to help you use a needle and thread to hang your fish in the aquarium. If you don't have a needle and thread you could use string and sticky tape.
