How to make a milk bottle whale catching game

What you will need:

- A clean, empty plastic milk bottle and lid
- A permanent marker or felt tip pen
- Scissors
- Scrap cardboard
- String or wool
- Double sided tape or glue



Make sure your milk bottle is clean and dry. Remove the lid but save it for later.



Draw an eye on your whale using a permanent marker. Do this on both sides.



Draw where you need to cut. The line goes all the way around the bottom and goes in for the mouth.



You can also draw the eye on cardboard and stick it to your whale.





Carefully cut along the line. Ask an adult to help you.



Draw a tail on some cardboard and cut it out.



Stick your tail to your whale. Double sided tape works well.



Draw a blow hole on your whales head.



Carefully make a hole in the lid of your milk bottle using scissors or a pen. Make a hole in the whale at the bottom of the mouth. A hole punch works well.



Tie the bottle lid to the whale using string or wool.



Draw some plastic pollution on a piece of cardboard and cut it out.



Stick the plastic pollution to the bottle lid. Now try to catch the pollution in the whales mouth!
