

How to make a decoupage jar!

You will need:

Clean glass jar
PVA glue
Paintbrush

Tissue paper or
patterned napkins



- 1 Start with a clean glass jar or bottle with the label removed.



- 2 Tear strips of tissue paper in different colours or cut shapes to make a pattern.

Build up layers of tissue paper, painting more glue mixture over each layer as you go.
