

# How to make a milk bottle elephant!

## You will need:

A clean empty plastic milk bottle

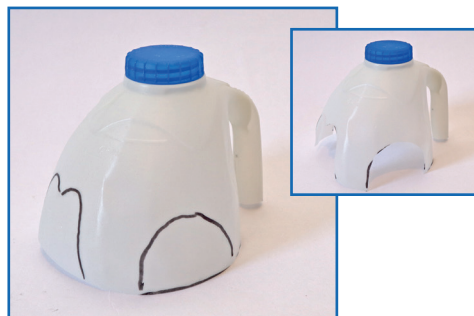
Scissors  
Glue  
Tissue paper  
Card



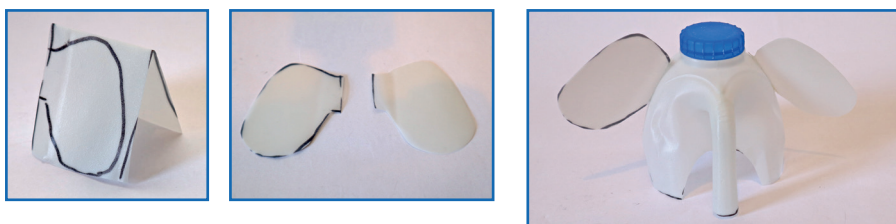
- 1** Start by cutting the base off a milk bottle. Cut through the handle and around the bottle.



- 2** Cut semi circles from the front and sides and an "m" shape at the back to make the legs and tail.



- 3** Cut 2 big ears out of some of the left over bottle plastic and tape them to the side of the bottle. Use the tabs to stick them. Double sided tape works best.

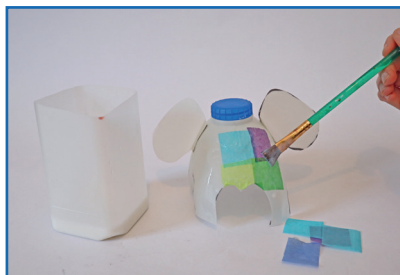

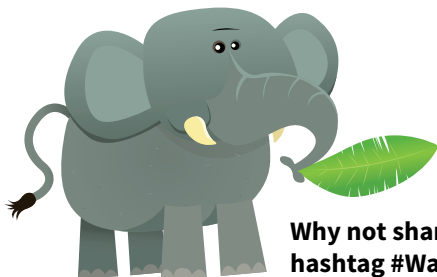
- 4 Mix PVA glue with a little water and paint it on the bottle. Stick pieces of tissue paper on top and cover in another layer of glue mixture.



- 5 Draw some eyes on some scrap cardboard. Cut out and tape or glue to your elephant.



- Always ask a grown up to help when using scissors
