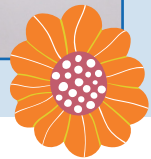


How to make magazine flowers!

You will need:

Old magazines Sticks - Kebab sticks,
Glue Stick old straws, chop stick,
Scissors pencil etc.
A jar or vase to display your flowers in







- 1 Cut some brightly coloured magazine pages and cut into wide strips.



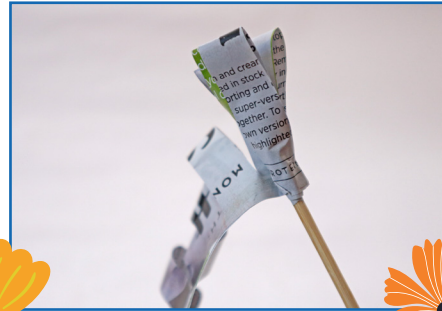
- 2 Glue along one long edge of the strip. Fold over and glue the two long edges together. Snip all the way along the length about 0.5cm apart, but not all the way through the strip. Put another strip of glue along the long edge you haven't snipped.



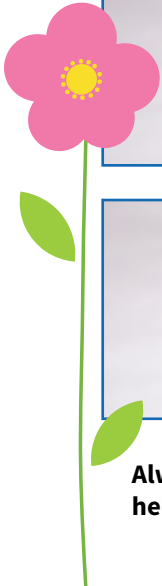
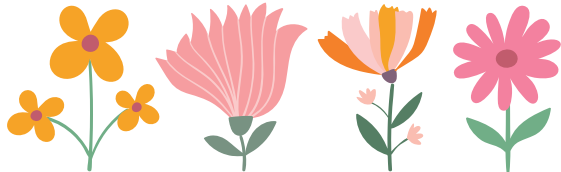
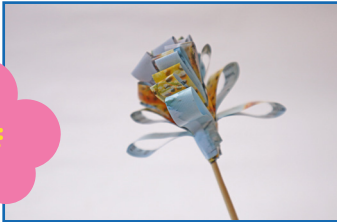

3 Wrap one end tightly around the end of your stick and continue to wrap the whole length around. You can wrap some tape around the bottom to help secure it if you need to.



4 Gently pull down and tease out the petals to create the flower. Make lots of flowers and put in a vase or clean jar. You could decorate this with ribbons.
