

How to make a pop bottle planter!

You will need:

Empty 2 litre pop bottle
A permanent marker
Scissors

Paint
Some compost
Seeds or a plant



- 1 Start with a clear plastic bottle. A 2 litre fizzy drink bottle is perfect.



Using some scissors, carefully cut the bottle in half- get an adult to help you.

- 2 Paint the inside of the bottle and leave to dry.



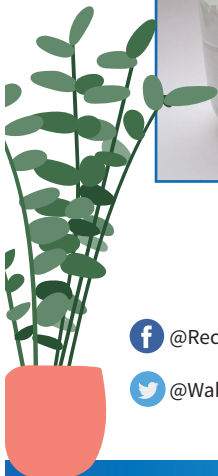

Use a permanent marker to draw where you want to cut the top to form the ears of the planter.
