

How to make a socktopus!



You will need:

An old or odd sock Cardboard
Scissors Felt tip pens
Glue

Something to stuff the sock with - other old socks, fabric scraps, cotton wool

Collect up old odd socks- make sure they are clean!

Stuff the foot of the sock to make a nice ball shape and tie some string or wool around to secure.

- 3** Use scissors to cut up to the string to create 8 legs.



Tip- pull each leg gently to make the fabric roll and curl.



- 4** Draw features on cardboard using felt tip pens and cut out.
